 - 3. JC refers to His Kingdom e.g. Mt 4:17, 23; 7²¹ 12:28; 13^{19, 41} Lk 18¹⁶ Jn 18:36
 - 4. Didn't rebuke adulation at Palm nor rebuff identification with Isaiah and Ze prophecies Lk 19:38; Mt 21:4-5; Jn 1:49
 - 5. Jesus declares His reign Mt 28:18
 - Jesus defeats enemy Mt 12:28; Rv 12:10
 - Jesus has a righteous scepter He 1:8
 - 8. Jesus executes justice Rv 19:11
 - Jesus will return to fulfill that reign
 Mt 26:64; Ph 2:10; 2Th 1:7-10; Rv 19:11-16
